**Venue** 15 Home Ave, Blackmans Bay, Tasmania



We are blessed with a perfect venue for discussing our conference theme for this year. For the duration of the whole conference, we have exclusive use of the Maryknoll House of Prayer Retreat and Conference Centre, which lies only a short walk from the beautiful waters of Blackmans Bay, approximately 15 mins south of Hobart. Run by the Tasmanian Presentation Sisters since 1979, the Centre offers a chapel for worship, a large conference room, a kitchen, dining room, and several smaller rooms that could be used for study group discussions. Accommodation is all on-site and consists of three double rooms, five twin rooms, and twelve single rooms; in addition there are three self-contained hermitages each suitable for a couple or small family. We'll do our best to provide attendees with requested accommodation. Beds all have electric blankets and each bedroom has an electric heater. Bed linen and towels are supplied.

**Catering** The Centre provides lunch and dinner every day as well as self-serve breakfast. In addition, tea, coffee and other refreshments will be available throughout the day.

**Excursion** There are two possibilities for the Sunday afternoon excursion depending on the weather, either a scenic tour of Hobart including afternoon tea or a ferry cruise on the Derwent.
