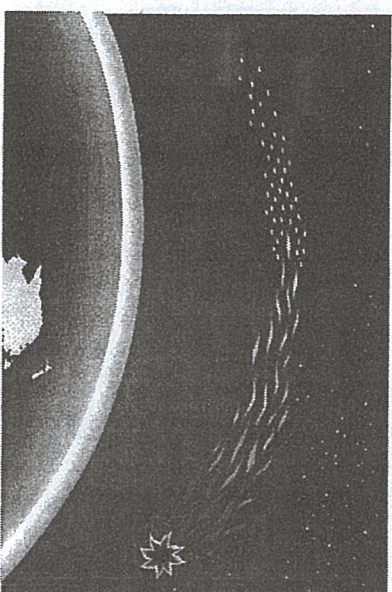

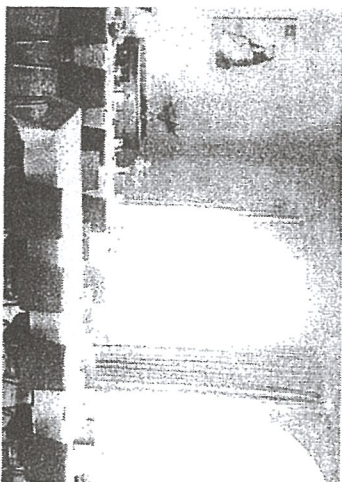
Those of us who will be arriving on Friday October 11

lunch on Monday October 14.**

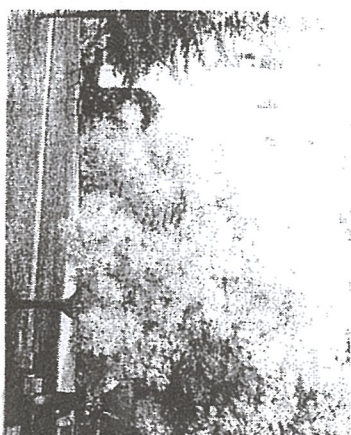

Please do not leave valuables unattended.

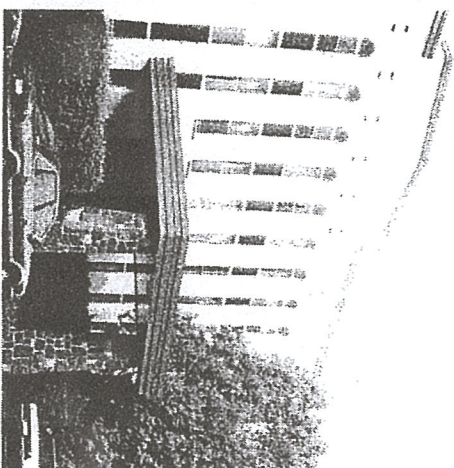


The accommodation is in comfortable single rooms
